### EPSOM SCHOOL DISTRICT WARRANT ARTICLES

**ARTICLE 1:** Shall the District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$8,632,869?

Should this article be defeated, the operating budget shall be \$8,548,461 which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the school district, or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. **YES 264**

**ARTICLE 3:** To see if the District will vote to create an expendable trust fund under the provisions of RSA 198:20-c, to be known as the special education trust fund, for the purpose of funding future special education costs. Furthermore, to raise and appropriate the sum of up to \$40,000 (from surplus) toward this transfer on July 1, 2010 and to name the school board as agents to expend from this fund. (Majority Vote Required).
