EPSOM POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT **March 2016**

NEWS:

- On March 2, 2016 Chief Preve and Lieutenant Michael responded to an attempted suicide at a residence on Blackhall Road. Upon arrival to the residence a male subject had a large butcher knife to his throat and was taken into custody after a brief standoff.
- On March 11, 2016 Chief Preve and Lieutenant Michael responded to a motor vehicle rollover at TD Bank with hazardous materials
- On March 12, 2016 Lieutenant Michael responded serious motor vehicle accident on Route 28 where one of the operators suffered life threatening injuries
- On March 13, 2016 Master Patrolman Fudala responded to a brawl at Hilltop Pizza, where several individuals had been in a physical altercation.
- March 15, 2016 Master Patrolman Kear responded to Pittsfield to assist a Pittsfield officer with a motor vehicle stop. During the incident Master Patrolman Kear and the Pittsfield officer were both assaulted.
- On March 17, 2016 Chief Preve responded to a burglary in progress on Barton Road, multiple police agencies responded to assist and three suspects were taken into custody.
- On March 21, 2016 a theft occurred overnight at M and M Ford theft in which an estimated \$8000 in vehicle parts was stolen.
- On March 29, 2016 a search warrant was executed on a vehicle that was seized for suspected drug activity. A quantity of illegal drugs was located in the vehicle and the owner currently has a warrant out for his arrest.
